## Our commitment



- Assessing climate-related risks and hazards, including considering any adaptation required to deliver assets and systems that are resilient to emerging and potential climate impacts
- Developing and supporting our people and contractors with the necessary systems, processes, expertise, and training to deliver on our environmental commitment
- Monitoring, reviewing, and reporting on our environmental performance, ensuring continual improvement
- Delivering energy solutions for regional and remote communities that respect the natural environment in which our communities thrive
